Laura Dannequin was born and raised in France. She trained in theatre and holds a BA (Hons) in Drama from the University of Exeter. She also trained independently in contemporary and baton dance, martial arts and aerial skills across Europe. As an independent dance artist, she has performed and collaborated with a range of choreographers, directors and film-makers including Sabina Topoganova, Fran Burke, Miranda Pinneri, Ben Beza, Philip Zandi and Michael Kien. Since 2004, Laura has been developing and presenting her own performance work in the UK and Ireland, including West of Nowhere, Land and Connet Down.

Mark Carberry, originally from Limerick, trained in dance at the Laban Conservatoire for Contemporary Dance. Mark has worked with a range of choreographers including Michael Kien, Alexei Ulyayev, Jane Krutikova and Colin Cree. Mark is currently working on his own choreographic practice. Recently he presented Knot at the Dublin Fringe Festival 2007. The Knot project is made up of four individuals who came together to investigate the nature of experience within the Möbius structure of time and space. Mark has been working with Daghdha Dance Company since 2005.
